Responsibilities

Project Integration Management:

Processes and activities needed to identify, define, combine, unify and coordinate the various processes and project management activities. Planning, Execution, Controlling, Closing.

Project Scope Management:

Processes required to ensure that the project include all the work required, and only the work required, to complete the project successfully.

Project Time Management: Processes required to manage timely completion of the project. Supports Defining Activities, Sequencing Activities, Estimating Activity Resources, Estimating Activity Durations, Developing a Schedule, and Controlling a Schedule.

Project Cost Management:

Processes involved in estimating, budgeting and controlling costs so that the project can be completed with the approved budget. Supports Estimating Costs, Determining Budget and Controlling Costs.

Project Quality Management:

Processes and activities that determine quality policies, objectives and responsibilities so that the project will satisfy the needs for which it was undertaken.

Project Human Resource Management:

Processes that organize, manage and lead the project team. Supports developing Human Resource Plan, Acquiring Project Team, Developing Project Team and Managing Project Team.

Project Communications Management:

Processes required to ensure timely and appropriate generation, collection, distribution, storage, retrieval and ultimate disposition of project information.

Project Risk Management:

Process of conducting risk management planning, identification, analysis, response planning and monitoring and controlling to increase the probability and impact of positive events and decrease the probability and impact of negative events.

On top of those typical Project Management activities the Project Manager is responsible to establish good relations with internal and external stakeholders making sure the Customer and Partner are satisfied with the results of the project. The Project Manager will also make sure the project is correctly reflected in the Cisco internal tools.
